## **Progress on Local Developments**



#### Forestwood Update

The old Forestwood corner continues to evolve, with new neighbors moving in by mid-June 2019! Greystar met with the neighborhood working team on Nov 27 to review beautification options for the Forest/Inwood corner park. Susan Parker represented HNA. Initially the park will include seasonal plantings and a power source for holiday lighting or up-lighting of a sculpture or other feature if added in the future.

A temporary Leasing Office will open Dec 15 at 5211 Forest Lane, #118 (across the street from the development). The entire development will be finished by May 2020 in phases.

Everleigh Forestwood Senior Living (55+) facility opens with 48 units in Jun 2019, with additional units coming available through Nov, 2019 (about 200 total). The first 6 Elan Inwood Townhomes will be ready in Sep, 2019 with additional townhomes available through May, 2020 (total 168). Elan Inwood Single-Family Homes will be ready for move-in starting Feb through May 2020 (12 total).

#### Progress on "Our" Section of Northaven Trail

Phase 2B-C from Cinderella Drive to Denton Drive should be finished in early 2019. Phase 2A (Preston Road to Cinderella Drive; goes through the Hockaday Neighborhood greenbelt) began this year. The entire western expansion should finish in late 2019.
